Third Sunday in Lent Year B, 3rd March 2024

Christ, the power and the wisdom of God

As we enter this third week of Lent, our readings remind us of God's love for us, soon to be witnessed in the suffering and death of Christ Jesus.

In the **First Reading**, God speaks to the people of Israel after their release from slavery in Egypt. The Ten Commandments show his people how to freely live in service of the One who has liberated them.

The **Psalm** speaks of the gifts the law of God brings in terms of wisdom, truth and life.

St Paul reflects on the way in which those who are called to follow Jesus see the crucified Christ. For those early Christians, and ourselves, this is not a sign of God's foolishness or weakness, but a demonstration to the world of God's power and wisdom. (**Second Reading**)

In this week's **Gospel**, we see Jesus sweep away the buyers and sellers from the Temple, which should be revered as the house of God. We are reminded that it is through Christ's suffering and death that salvation will come, and the power and wisdom of God will be revealed.

This week, perhaps we can pray for all those areas of the world where places of holiness and sanctuary are debased and de-valued. We pray too, for all people who are prevented from worshipping openly, and from practising their faith in freedom.



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners.

I greet you a blessed month of March!

We are already in the middle of our Lenten journey as a parish community, this 3rd Sunday of lent. It is good to remind ourselves that we are called to have a deeper relationship with God during this season though the pious practices of Fasting, Prayer & Alms giving. It may happen though that sometimes we become lukewarm, we procrastinate, or we busy our self with other legitimate things that we need to do. We need to persevere by constantly reminding our self that Jesus is always waiting for us to come to Him so He may refresh us, nourish us and strengthen us in this Lenten journey.

We witnessed for the past two Sundays the installation and commissioning of our Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. We prayed for them so that they may "continue to strive more earnestly than ever to live the Christian life, to give good examples through their service to the parish and to take their faith more seriously." I congratulate all our Lectors and EMHC together with their families for saying Yes to humble service to our parish.

During this season of Lent, I ask you to pray for our catechumens who are preparing to receive the sacraments on Easter vigil. They already expressed their willingness to receive these sacraments at the Mass of the Rite of Election on the First Sunday of Lent at the Holy Rosary Cathedral and they are now in the Period of Purification and Enlightenment. It is a time of reflection, intensely centered on conversion, marked by celebration of the scrutinies for and presentations for 3 Sundays and of the preparation rites on Holy Thursday.

We will have our Parish Lenten Mission on March15 to 17. It will be led by Father Martin Scott who is from the Archdiocese of Lima, Peru. The mission talks will be in the evening and after each mission talk, I encourage you to contribute generously by donating cash to "Free Will Love Offering" for Fr Scott's charitable work and mission in Peru. You can read his short biography in this bulletin.

Lastly our Parish Lenten Penitential Service is on March 19, Tuesday at 7 in the evening. It is also the solemnity of St. Joseph, Principal Patron of Canada and Patron of the Universal Church. There will be four priests to assist in hearing confession. I encourage you to see this sacrament as part of our Lenten practice, or a time of renewal, because I firmly believe that this sacrament is a powerful mean to bring about ongoing renewal and conversion of heart, not only individually but also as a parish community.

Have a blessed season of Lent!

PARISH LENTEN MISSION BY FR. MARTIN SCOTT



Padre Martín Scott, formally Rev. P Ricardo Scott Chavanches, attended Mount Saint Mary's Seminary in Emmittsburg, Maryland. In May 1988 he was ordained a diocesan priest

for the Archdiocese of Washington D.C. For the next 15 years he was assigned to several parishes in the diocese. In 2003 he was granted permission from the Archdiocese of Washington D.C. to move to Peru with all of his priestly faculties. He is the founder of the religious community called "Siervos de la Divina Misericordia" in Chosica, Peru. He is a missionary priest whose religious community lives entirely off Divine Providence. The charism of his religious community life is based on the messages concerning our Lord's infinite Divine Mercy given to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska.
