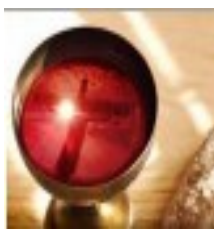

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Year B, 2nd June 2024

‘Take it’ Jesus said, ‘this is my blood, which
is to be poured out for many.’

The feast of Corpus Christi is a celebration of the new covenant of Christ with his people: the covenant of his blood, where he offered himself as a perfect sign of his love for us.

The **First Reading** is a description of the ritual that sealed God’s covenant with his people. In ancient times, blood was a symbol of life, and its sprinkling signifies the Israelites’ desire to participate in a relationship with God, to share his life and to become his people. Centuries later, the symbolism of this act was brought to an entirely different level by the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross.

This relationship is taken up in the **Psalms**, where the covenanted people express their thanksgiving for all that God has done for them, and their readiness to fulfil their responsibilities to him.

The **Gospel** narrative of the Last Supper tells of the new covenant, so much more wonderful and powerful than the old. Jesus’s action at the Passover table is a ritual that anticipates his brutal, yet life-giving, death. Christ’s deep compassion for humankind inaugurates this new covenant, a new relationship of love between God and his people.

The **Second Reading** reminds us that the blood of the new covenant is from God’s own Son, so we can literally share in Christ’s life, becoming the ‘blood sisters and brothers’ of Jesus, and children of the one Father. This week, we might pray with the author of this letter for help to purify our inner selves from dead actions, so that we do our service to the living God.

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Happy Parish Feast Day!

We celebrate today June 2, our parish feast day, the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. Originally proposed as a feast day by St Thomas Aquinas, this liturgical solemnity honors the Eucharist, reminding all to recognize that it is the True Presence – the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ. He once said that "The Eucharist is the sacrament of love: it signifies love, it produces love. The Eucharist is the consummation of the whole spiritual life."

On June 7, the first Friday of the month, we will celebrate the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which reminds us "what divine love looks like in a world of sin: a love that suffuses everything and gives it life and dynamism; a love that takes on human flesh and chooses to accept suffering for the sake of remaining faithful to the transfiguring project it desires to see through to the end; a love that offers itself to us to make us participants and partners in a labor of love for the world" (Living With Christ).

On June 16 we will celebrate Father's Day and our minds and hearts turn to dads, father figures, spiritual fathers and mentors in our lives. Whether we have positive and good relationship and experiences with our earthly fathers or not so positive experiences we lift them up in prayer to our Heavenly Father who loves us all as his children.

Congratulations to our Grade 2 students who received the First Holy Communion at the Mass on June 1. I pray that you may always stay close to Jesus whom you received. Congratulations also to the Grade 7 students who were Confirmed last May 25. I pray that you will now publicly confirm and affirm the faith that you received at your Baptism.

Lastly, I would like to express my gratitude to the teachers, catechists, and parents of our Grade 2 and Grade 7 students for nurturing and guiding your children on their faith journey. I pray and encourage you to continue to do so in the years ahead.

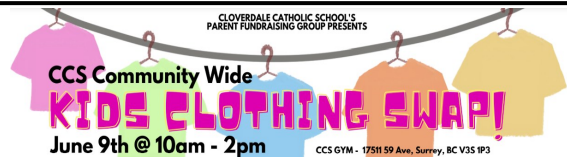


PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

Catholic Pacific College –Fundraising Dinner

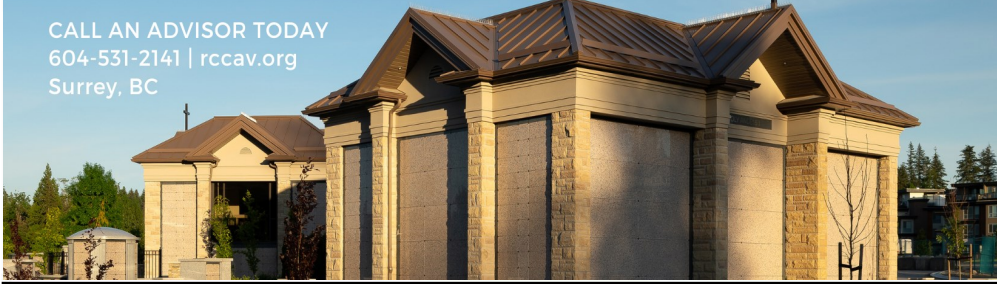
