'Love the Lord your God, and love your neighbour as yourself.'

The readings this week remind us that the love of God and the love of other people lie at the core of our lives as Christians.

In the **First Reading**, Moses reminds the people of Israel, who are about to enter the promised land, that they must love God with all their heart, soul and strength.

The **Psalm** expresses our love for God, who is our rock and our refuge. It praises the God who has done so much for us.

The writer of the letter to the Hebrews (**Second Reading**) speaks of Jesus as the ideal high priest. Unlike previous high priests, he lives for ever, and can 'intercede for all who come to God through him'.

Answering the question posed by a scribe in the **Gospel**, Jesus goes beyond the exhortation of Moses. We are indeed to love God, but we must also love our neighbour. Love of God, the greatest commandment, is inseparable from love of neighbour.

This week, we might want to focus our prayer on the people around us, near and far, that they should know and love the Lord, and live in peace.

Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners

I hope you are enjoying the colors of the Fall season! I am amazed at how bright green leaves are turning to yellow and orange and brown! I also like the sound of the crunching leaves underfoot whenever I walked around our property. While we enjoy what Mother Nature has given us there are also sad news of natural disaster in other parts of the globe like flood, typhoon, and hurricane. The colors of Fall season though, do not last long as it gives way to winter season. We see in these changing of seasons the necessary cycle of life – birth, death and renewal.

Last Friday, November 1, we celebrated the beginning of the month of November with the Feast of All Saints followed by the Feast of All Souls on Saturday. These two celebrations are reminders for us that we will leave this world someday and our true home is Heaven. For the whole month we will pray and remember in our Mass our deceased loved ones and friends, former parishioners, and benefactors.

On November 11, "Canadians pause... in silence to remember those who died in war and to pray for the victims of aggression and inhumanity throughout the world. This is a day to pray for peace, to consider what we are doing as individuals, as a community and as a nation to bring God's peace into the world. This is a day when a believing community should rededicate itself by prayer and action to the ideals Jesus gives us in the Beatitudes" (Ordo Liturgical Calendar 2023-2024, p. 246).

On November 17 we observe the World Day of the Poor. Pope Francis established this day in 2017 to encourage people to reflect on poverty and take action to help those in need. There are many poor in the world and each year the number is growing. While Jesus told us that we will always have the poor with us (Matthew 26.11), it is important to remember that poor people are not "outside" our communities. They are our brothers and sisters whose suffering we should ease, to restore them to our common brotherhood (Pope Francis, Message for 5th World Day of the Poor).

November is also the last month in our liturgical calendar. We celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe on November 24, the last Sunday of this month. This solemnity stands as a magnificent masterpiece and invites us to reflect deeply on the divine kingship of Christ and its profound significance in our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ. I always pray for you and your loved ones that Christ's kingship may forever inspire you to live lives of faith, love, and devotion, proclaiming His kingship not only in our words but in the very fabric of our existence.
